EXCELLENCE IN EDUCATION

Beth Mead gave a summary of the Industry Immersion events that were held in June 2022. She then introduced Julia Johnson Baer, ECE instructor for Jefferson High School, to describe her experiences in the Industry Immersion workshop this summer. Ms. Baer spoke about connecting to business partners who were in attendance and how they can help students. Ms. Baer then discussed the site visits that reiterated classroom lessons in real world applications, she described the tours as "…powerful…". Ms. Schultz from RVC added how pleased she was with the Industry Immersion and how she had several instructors that were also in attendance. Dr. Schwuchow indicated he had several instructors advise him how positive the event was as well.

- The FY22 Grant is closed, and all funds have been expended.
- FY23 Grant has been approved, all Districts have submitted their Grant Plans, and Perkins Phase 1 purchasing is underway.
- Pathway targets for FY23 are Manufacturing, Transportation, Health Science, and Education.
 Emerging target are Construction, Leisure & Hospitality, and Information Technology
- Statewide EFE Directors have not been given specific information on the Program Quality Review; however, CEANCI expects this will need to be completed before the close of FY23.
- HB3296 Public Act 102-0917 (College & Career Pathway Endorsements) was discussed at the EFE Director Training workshop Ms. Dougherty attended in August. Many schools are already working on this directive and CEANCI will facilitate where needed to ensure all region districts are complying by the first deadline.

• Ms. Dougherty reviewed the System Director Goals for the year, they are included in the System Director notes attached.

• Ms. Dougherty reviewed fund allocations to the districts, the FY23 Carl Perkins Grant allocation to CEANCI will be \$675,000 and the CTEI Grant allocation will be \$700,215.

- Enrollment in CEP is back to pre-pandemic levels this year, with 38 total participants, 23 in Cosmetology, 10 in Medical Science, and 5 in the Auto Program at Hononegah High School.
- Billing for FY23 CEP has been invoiced and 5 of the 6 districts have paid their invoice.
